States Requiring NCCAOM Certification

The following is a list of states that require NCCAOM certification and a list of the Functional Diagnostic Medicine Training Program modules with approved PDA points.

Acupuncturists in these states are currently required to obtain a total of 60 PDA points over a (4) year period for license recertification. Upon completion of a FDM training module and passing examination, you will be eligible for a certificate of completion that will contain all information necessary for recertification.

Acupuncturists practicing in the state of California must submit verification of continuing education hours/credits by a board approved continuing education provider. The following indicates the CE requirements for license renewal:

<u>Period of Initial Licensure</u>	<u>Required CE Hours</u>
13 to 16 months	35
17 to 20 months	40
21 to 23 months	45
Thereafter	50 every two years

Up to 50% of the continuing education requirements may be completed through on-line courses, distance education, or correspondence courses.
